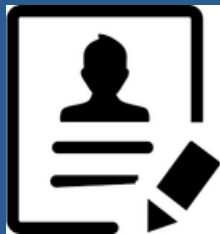

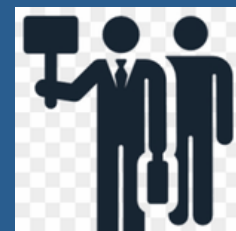
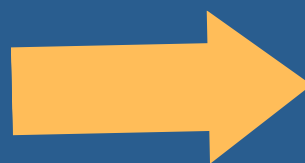

DIGITAL LITERACY

Digital Literacy refers to the knowledge, skills and attitudes that allow children to be both safe and empowered in an increasingly digital world. Digital literacy equips students with the necessary skills to navigate through these challenges effectively, enabling them to become responsible digital citizens. The increased use of technology in education has made digital literacy skills more essential than ever.

Keeping in mind the need and importance of digital literacy, we have tried to run this project successfully throughout the year.

Intervention we offer



We implemented Digital Literacy Project in Raipur District of Chhattisgarh State. In the first step of this program, we sensitized 485 teachers of 49 Government high & Senior Secondary Schools about digital literacy.



With digital literacy, students can learn to be safe online and engage with others safely, safeguarding their personal information and keeping themselves and others safe from online threats, crime etc.

In the second step of the project, we sensitized students of classes 8 to 12 about digital literacy in all 49 schools.



We empowered more than 24000 students from 49 schools with relevant skills and competencies under Digital Literacy Program. We completed this program with the help of trained project team, school teachers and volunteers.

WATERSHED

Watershed management is the process of implementing land use practices and water management practices to protect and improve the quality of the water and other natural resources within a watershed. It helps to control pollution of the water and other natural resources in the watershed by identifying the different kinds of pollution present in the watershed and how those pollutants are transported, and recommending ways to reduce or eliminate those pollution sources.

ESG SUSTAINABILITY

Under ESG sustainability, we have installed solar street lights in remote areas. Solar street lights require very little maintenance as compared to conventional street lights. Since external wiring has been removed, the risk of accidents is reduced. Electricity produced from solar panels is non-polluting. Each of these solar lights provides sufficient visibility at any time of night. This lighting solution increases security for communities, deters crime, enhances safety, and saves money.

STEM EDUCATION

India is one of the countries around the world that has the highest number of engineers and scientists, STEM education has to become an integral part of the curriculum in various schools in India. Also, due to the rising popularity and demand for STEM skills in various industries globally, it makes sense to impart STEM learning to children right from a young age.

The STEM approach to education fosters creativity and divergent thinking alongside fundamental disciplines. It motivates and inspires young people to generate new technologies and ideas. With a focus on practice and innovation, students get to learn from inquiry-based assignments. It helps teachers in teaching with focus on subjects like science and maths.

Intervention we offer



Before the STEM lab installation, infrastructure was developed in both the schools, in which we repaired and painted the wall, ceiling and floor in the room, making the room STEM lab friendly.



After the renovation of Lab room, we have installed 90+ Working & DIY Models including the backdrops and IEC of STEM lab in both of school.



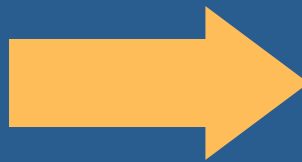
We conducted STEM lab teaching training for 19 teachers from both the schools. Physical training was given to all the teachers 2 times, which includes the advanced teaching process and orientation of models and activity sheets during the training.



To assess the benefits of STEM lab education, we have organized 4 quiz competitions in each school in a year. Weak children found during the quiz were assessed and teachers were informed about how to teach them.



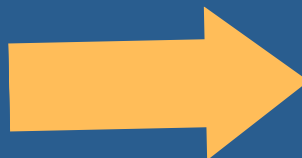

AGRICULTURE & LIVELIHOOD

Agriculture is the practice of cultivating natural resources to sustain human life and provide economic gain. Agriculture also provides opportunities for economic equity and helps people prosper around the world. Agriculture impacts society in many ways, including: supporting livelihoods through food, habitat, and jobs; providing raw materials for food and other products; and building strong economies through trade.

Training under Agriculture and Livelihood aims to reduce poverty and inequality by creating employment among poor households and leading highly vulnerable households towards sustainable livelihoods and economic stability.

Intervention we offer

Organic Farming Training to 100 Farmers

Vermicomposting training to 80 Farmers

Mushroom Training to 120 Farmers

**Commercial Vegetable Farming Training to
60 Farmers**

Animal Husbandry Training to 70 Farmers



HEALTH CAMPS

A Free medical Camp can be considered as a life-saving program because it aims to provide free Health check - ups and Medicine to marginalised population living in rural or urban areas by a mobile team with varieties of medical specialized services. Through medical camps we provided free medical advice, medicines to the people and referred them for special treatment or surgery whenever required.

Through the camps, we made sure that people are getting healthcare on time, and they are going to the doctor before a minor health problem turns into a serious one.

Intervention we offer

The Mobile OPD facility with free medicine was made available in 8 villages.

A total of 870 patients were consulted and medicines were distributed.

47 cases were referred to the government hospital,

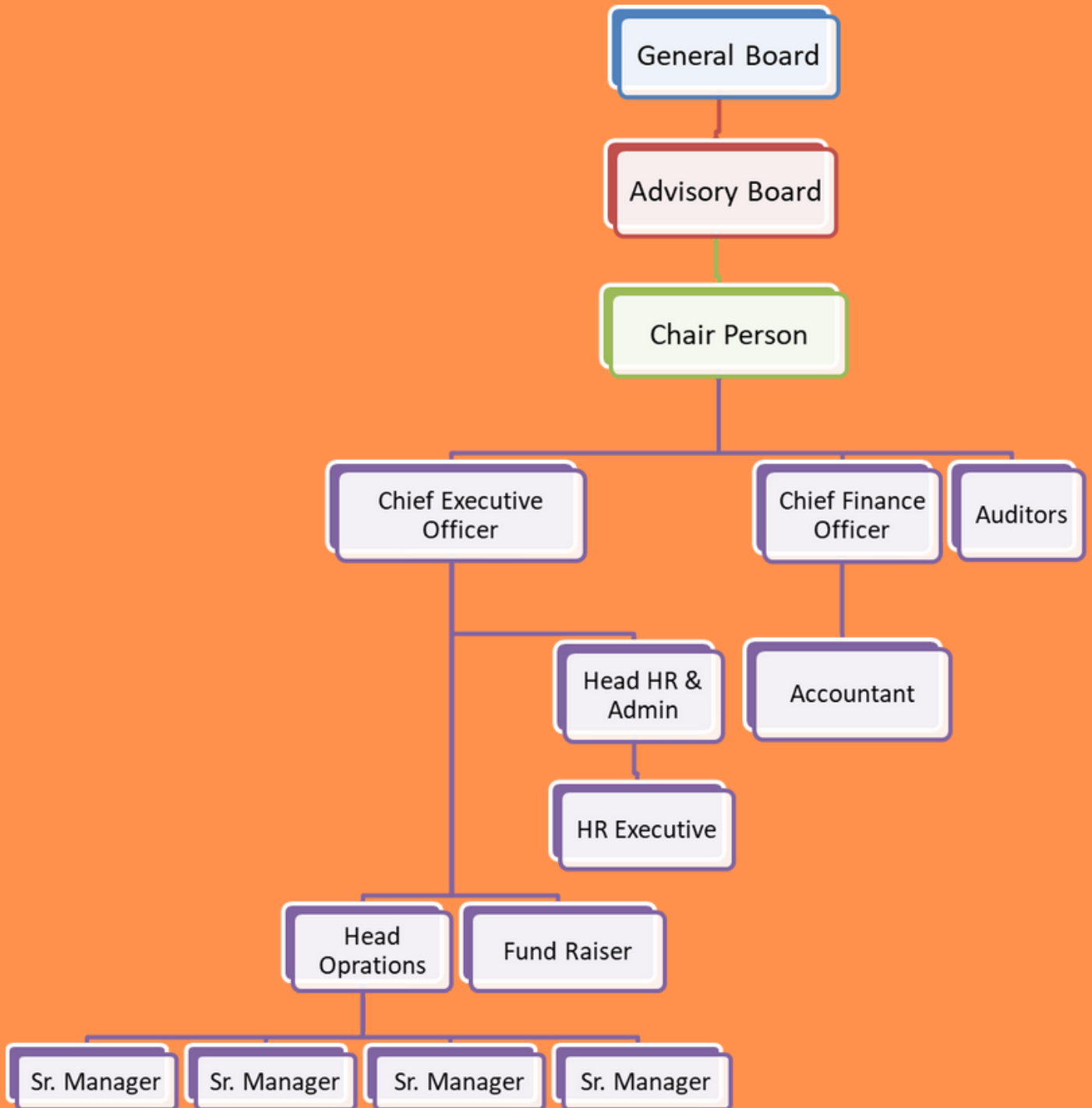
Formed 8 village health committees, oriented them and linked them to the government health system.

With 2 specialised doctors, we have organised 2 special health camp, In which 544 people from 8 villages got benefit.

A training session has been organised for Anganwadi/ Asha workers on capacity building.
